Dear Parent(s),

Everyone has settled back well in Toonagh NS and well done to all the children. A special welcome and well done to our new Junior Infants: *Ida, Kate, Hannah, Caden, Jack* and *Donnchadh*, who have all settled in so well to school.

There are a number of important items that I would like to bring to your attention in this back to school newsletter:

Free School Book Scheme:

On return to school, all your child's school books (covered) and copybooks were distributed. Thanks to Seán Eustace for organising the whole process of this for our school and thanks to Mary and Maelisa for assisting Seán.

School Fees Payment 2023-24:

An epayment request for the school fees 2023-24 will issue in the coming days. The cost will be €40 per pupil and maximum of €80 per family. This payment will include a fee for pupil insurance (24 hour, 365 day cover), and a contribution to help with the expense of the following: Art and Craft materials for the children, photocopying and printing, Aladdin message a parent system, Accelerated Reader Licences, Digital licences and Literacy Lift Off programme.

Pupils will be asked to pay €5 for a bus trip to a match or field trip. The cost of buses last year was extremely expensive on the school and we expect a similar cost this school year. €5 towards a bus trip will help contribute towards this cost. If your child is going on a bus journey to a match or a field trip you will receive an epayment request for €5.

I also realise that back to school payments can be difficult for some families, in this case please contact me and I will give financial help in the strictest confidence. Also please note you can spread out the payments on the Aladdin epayments system.

Morning Drop Off and Evening Collection Arrangements:

1. **Morning Drop Off:** The school doors will be open from 9.05 each morning, strictly no children on the school grounds before the doors open as we there will be no supervision. The doors will be opened at approx. 9.05am and supervision will start at this time.
2. **Evening Collection:** Only children going on the school buses will enter or exit the school through the main school gate, it is not safe for children to walk out this gate onto the road. All other entry or exit from the school should be via the pedestrian gate.

We do not recommend any child to be collected via our back gate outside Toonagh Hall or by the wall where the double yellow lines are. We recommend all children to leave via our pedestrian gate and be collected from here.

If any children are leaving the school via the back gate and steps near Toonagh Hall, **parents/adults must collect them from the top of the steps and be visible** to the teacher on evening supervision as we will not allow any child leave through this gate unsupervised due to cars turning here and walking directly onto the road. The safest exit point for children is our pedestrian gate.

Thanks for your cooperation and the continued safety of all our children is of utmost importance.

Please note our secretary Noelette works on **Mondays, Wednesdays** and **Fridays** and you can contact the school on these days by phone. Outside of these days we check the school voicemail at the end of the school day. Outside of these days and times the phone will rarely be answered as all staff are in class. Absences:

As a parent, you must let the school know if your child is absent and the reason why. It is school policy that reasons must be given in writing to the class teacher. Please supply the class teacher with a written note or email explaining the reason for absence for the school's records.

The school must notify TUSLA – Child and Family Agency when a child is absent for 20 days or more or where the absences gives rise to concern.

Healthy Lunches:

Our school continues to promote healthy eating with a Healthy Lunch Policy in the school. Sweets, chocolate bars, crisps and fizzy drinks are not permitted. One small treat is permitted on Friday which can be eaten at big lunch. We look forward to embracing a healthy school. Many thanks for your continued co-operation.

Label belongings:

Please ensure that all your child's belongings are clearly labelled; Jumpers, Tracksuits, Coats etc as they can get mixed up at times.

Half Day Closure for Staff Planning and Training:

The school will close on **Wednesday October 4th** @12.30 pm for a half day for a Staff meeting to facilitate staff planning. Buses will operate as normal at this time.

Junior Infant Parent Information Session:

An information session for the Junior Infant parents will be held on Friday 13th of October @ 2.00 pm in the Junior Infant Classroom. The Junior Infants can also be supervised here at school while you attend.

Board of Management Summer Works and Maintenance:

The Board of Management has been busy preparing the school premises and grounds for the new school year. I would like to extend thanks especially to Seán Eustace for ensuring that the school was in pristine condition for the return of the pupils; organising landscaping work as well as a deep clean of the interior of our school building. Teacher Courses:

Under rule 58 of the Rules for Primary Schools, teachers are entitled to 3 Extra Personal Vacation (EPV) days on foot of taking part in approved summer courses. Over the summer, many of the teachers in the school have taken the time to complete these invaluable courses in a variety of valuable areas. The Department of Education will not cover the cost of a substitute for one of the three days per teacher. The Board of Management will cover the cost of a substitute for one of the three days per teacher and class will need to be split up into other classrooms for the other teacher course day absences.

School Sport:

- **Hurling:** Ann McMahon is coaching hurling, camogie and fundamental movement skills for all classes on Fridays. The children from 3rd - 6th are asked to bring in their own hurley and helmet every Friday. Children from Juniors to 2nd don't need to bring in any equipment for now, we provide all children from Juniors to 2nd with a hurley for this coaching session. Thanks to Ruan GAA Club for funding this excellent Physical Education initiative for the girls and boys.
- **Cross Country:** The Cross Country Running Competition for children in 1st – 6th Class will take place in Lees Road on Wednesday September 27th starting at 10.30am. All children in these classes are encouraged to take part if possible. An epayment request for the entry fee (€3) and bus fee (€5) will issue soon.

Clothes Collection Fundraiser:
