Dear Parent(s),

I would like to bring the following to your attention in this November newsletter.

COVID-19 Toonagh NS Response Plan and Antigen Testing:

The main concern for our school and all schools at present is COVID-19.

The Department of Education have confirmed arrangements for a new system of antigen testing of asymptomatic close contacts in primary schools from Monday November 29th.

How this will work:

- When a parent receives a positive PCR COVID-19 test result on their child, they should notify the school.
- The school principal will inform the parents of the other children in the pod of a confirmed case, that they are close contacts of a confirmed COVID-19 case. No personal details of the child will be shared.
- Parents will be provided with the option to receive free antigen tests from the distribution company for their child, which they will be able to order for delivery to their home.
- Parents carry out the antigen test on the day that they receive it and every second day until three tests have been done.
- The children in the pod can continue to attend school as long as they remain asymptomatic and their antigen test results show a negative result.
- Where two or more cases arise in a class, within a seven-day period, outside of a single pod, antigen testing will be offered to the full class.

If a child's antigen test indicates a positive result:

- If an antigen test is positive, the child isolates at home and the child's parent/guardian logs onto the HSE to request a PCR COVID-19 test.
- The antigen test distribution company will record the numbers of antigen tests distributed, batch numbers and the names of the relevant schools.

If a child develops symptoms of COVID-19:

- If at any stage a child becomes symptomatic they should isolate at home and organise a PCR COVID-19 test. A negative antigen test holds no value in the situation of a symptomatic child.

Ventilation:

With the season of winter upon us, heating will be on in the school. It is necessary however, to have good circulation of clean air and for this reason windows will be kept open throughout the day. Good ventilation will be achieved by opening windows and doors before school and during breaks. During class time windows may be partially opened. Please ensure that your child is dressed in warm layers under their uniform and tracksuit if required.

Parent Teacher Meetings:

Parent Teacher meetings have taken place by phone recently due to current restrictions and thanks for your understanding on this.

Active School Flag Award

Our new Active Flag which we earned over the last 2 years for healthy and sporting activity was raised on Friday last by Councillor Mary Howard and her niece Tegan from second class. The 'walking and talking' initiative continues each morning in designated areas before school starts for each class bubble. The children take part in PE each Tuesday and Friday, every Friday all children in the school take part in hurling and camogie with GAA coach Anne McMahon. Children from $3^{rd} - 6^{th}$ are asked to bring in their hurley and helmet every Friday while we provide hurleys for all the boys and girls from Juniors - 2^{nd} .
