The Board has decided to purchase hand sanitiser and dispensers for the school. A lot of effort has been put into sourcing a suitable sanitiser for the school and the sanitiser sourced is certified to kill Covid-19. These will be installed in the school during the summer holidays.

6. Summer works project

The Board of Management received notification this month that an application for a Summer Works Grant was successful and we will now be able to proceed with some important work on our school grounds. Some of the works will include a full resurfacing and drainage of our two school yards which are in need of repair. The main yard in front of our school will be resurfaced and designs for games for our younger children will be marked on our new yard. Our basketball court will also be fully resurfaced and lined. Cotter Plant Hire were successful in the tendering process and they will carry out the Summer Works Project. The children will really benefit from our new yards which will be a safe and enjoyable playing environment for them. It is great news to be getting these works done during the summer.
